Provider Access Statement



1. Legal Status

1.1. This policy statement sets out the school's arrangement for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school and for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer.  - 2.1.4. Availability
- 2.2. This Policy is made available to parents, staff and pupils via the Academy website and on request a copy may be obtained from the main office.

3. Opportunities for Access

A number of events, integrated into the school careers programme, will offer providers an opportunity to come into school to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers. Please speak to our Careers Lead (contact details below) to identify the most suitable opportunity for you.

4. Premises and Facilities

- 4.1. The school will make the main hall, classrooms and/or meeting rooms available for discussions between the provider and the students, as appropriate to the activity and available on the date/time required. The school will also make available AV and specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit/event.
- 4.2. Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature which will be distributed to students as appropriate.
